Kim Peterson, from Hospice of
North Iowa spoke regarding the
services of this Mercy Health
Network facility.

Hospice helps patients and their
families cope with a terminal illness.
People of all ages and with any type
of life-limiting illness may receive
hospice care.

Care is provided in the home,
nursing home, assisted living,
hospital or the hospice inpatient
unit. In other words, hospice
provides care wherever the patient
is, and continues this care even if
the patient transfers from location to
location.

Kim also told us about "Camp
Green Tree". This program is
designed to help youth, ages 7-14,
normalize the grief experience. It
pairs up young people who have
experienced the death of a loved
one.
