- This project is funded by the State at 9 million, Local government at 3 million and private donations at 1 million.
- The project will take place at the west end of Clear Lake
- The lake in the project area is currently 4-6 feet deep, will be 25 feet deep when completed.
- They have purchased a containment site approximately 2 miles SW of the Lake.
- They now need to build berms and dikes on the containment site of 12 feet on all sides on 200 acres.
- The containment site will be converted to a wildlife area when completed.
- The actual process will be hydraulic dredging. The silt and water will be pumped out of the bottom of the lake and pumped to the containment site. Basically, a giant vacuum cleaner attached to a barge.

- Dredging will take place over 2 open water seasons operating 24/7.
- Approximately 64 percent of the phosphorus will be removed from the lake. The algae feed on phosphorus. This should control the algae blooms in the lake.
- Dredging provides long term solutions to the water quality impairments of the lake.
