and 64 percent of these people are
women and girls.

with whom RI has a Board-approved
cooperative relationship), and in
Rotary Literacy Month next March.

Over the next year, RI President
[Bill Boyd's Literacy Resource Group](#)
will raise awareness of literacy
issues and encourage Rotary clubs
to undertake literacy projects both
at home and abroad.
