## **Rotary Foundation Minute #2**

Today's Rotary Foundation Minute is provided as a reminder to ALL of us that the Foundation is the primary way in which we are involved in the 4<sup>th</sup> avenue of service — **International Service**.

The Foundation was established. "*For the purpose of doing good in the world* in charitable, educational, and other avenues of community service." It took eleven years — from 1917 to 1928, before the Foundation had assets of \$5,000. In 1930 the very first grant was made to the International Society for Crippled Children - later to be known as the Easter Seals organization. Like the proverbial acorn, the Foundation has grown to a mighty oak. Last year Rotarians contributed over \$91 million to the Annual Programs Fund, \$13 million to the Permanent Fund, and \$23 million in Restricted Giving, a total of \$127 million! We are making a difference throughout the world.
